

**DAILY SCREENING PROCEDURE – to be undertaken every morning before school.**

(According to the Department of Health p. 10, 5.2.2 of the document, DBE Standard Operating Procedure for Covid-19, on our website).

Parents/Guardians must ask learners the following questions:

1. Do you have a high temperature?
2. Do you have a cough?
3. Do you have a sore throat?
4. Do you have difficulty breathing (shortness of breath)?
5. Do you feel weak and tired today?
6. Can you taste food and drinks normally?
7. Can you smell normally?

The answer to the first five questions should be no, and to the last two questions, yes.

If not, please keep your child at home for self-isolation or contact the Health Department to arrange a COVID-19 test.

The school should be informed and kept up-to-date until the learner is allowed to return to school by the health authorities.

The learner will have his/her temperature taken before entering the school premises. The normal human temperature is 36,5 – 37,5°C. If a learner tests higher than 38°C he/she will not be allowed to enter the school premises.
