Matric Results for 2018

Merit/Demerit System/Diary

The system functions as follows: 5 demerits – Friday detention; 10 demerits – meeting with parents; 10 merits with no demerits – Principal's tea. Parents must check the diary for demerits/merits once a week – it provides an indication of your child's behaviour at school.

The diary must be checked on a daily basis to ensure that your child completes homework and tasks on time and prepares for scheduled tests in advance.

Late comers

Late comers' detention will be implemented from next week every Thursday after school for 1 hour. If a pupil is late for school 5 times, he/she will serve the detention. It is ironic that the transport drivers who bring them to school late are not prepared to wait for these children. Please inform your child's transport that no exceptions will be made.

New Parents

A reminder to our parents that any problems experienced by pupils must be reported to the school and will be referred to the Heads of department (GET and FET). A school counsellor is available for pupils on Mondays and Tuesdays.

Extra-murals

Our extra-murals start on Monday, 21 January. Please encourage your child to participate in at least 2 activities. This is how they become part of the College in a holistic manner.

Cell Phones

Cell phones are not allowed at school or while in school uniform (off the school premises). If a cell phone is confiscated a fine of R200-00 must be paid after one week to recover it.
